
Principles for community empowerment



Current position - Community Health

- All HI Teams actively engaged in Community Planning Partnerships – widespread advocacy actions
- Most Boards routinely commission activity from Third Sector Interface - added value of sector in delivery of outcomes
- Priority determined by local Board/ HSCP priorities with sizable variations
- Capacity and capability of the HI workforce determines the nature of the approach and the level of engagement
- The partnership infrastructure and capacity of local organisations is generally regarded as reduced and insufficient to robustly engage with / build capacity of communities.
