# 4. Update on meetings and collaboration

GMcC gave an update to the group on the following:

### 13<sup>th</sup> November 2018-Mortality Workshop:

- This was an opportunity for different bodies to share what they were doing, this included looking at different hypothesis to what is causing the trends, confirm what the similar issues are and look at what we can collaborate on or join up with to some degree.
